PURPOSE STATEMENTS AND PRINCIPLES

Job Description Supplement

Board member job descriptions reference the Purpose Statements and Principles of the Elk Island Logos Society. This document reiterates these from the most recently approved handbook.

Purpose Statement

Our children's learning environment will enhance their understanding of God's love and His Word. Teachers and administrators will receive our support through prayer, fundraising and volunteer work. Our schools and communities will be positively impacted by the presence of the Logos program.

Principles

1. God is our Creator who knows and loves everyone.
2. The Bible is the primary resource for Christian teaching.
3. The Old and New Testaments of the Bible are the inspired Word of God.
4. There is one God, eternally existing in three persons:
 - a. God the Father,
 - b. Jesus Christ, His only Son, and
 - c. The Holy Spirit.
5. Jesus lived on the Earth, was crucified, and rose again so that we are forgiven.
6. Salvation is given to those who accept Him as their personal Savior.
7. He strengthens us through His Holy Spirit.
8. We live on Earth to love God and serve Him by caring for and serving others.
9. We devote time to God by reading His Word and speaking to Him through prayer.

BYLAWS SPECIFIC TO THE BOARD

The Board Section of the Bylaws

1. The Board shall consist of (a) between seven and nine Officers, each serving for a two year term, and elected by a majority vote at a meeting of the membership; and (b) one School Representative from each Logos school, each serving for a one-year term, and affirmed at a meeting of the membership. (The school Rep role can be shared between two people.)
2. The terms of the Officers of the Board shall expire as follows: - Even-numbered years – Vice President, Treasurer, 1st Director, 3rd Director, and 5th Director - Odd-numbered years – President, Secretary, 2nd Director, and 4th Director
3. In the case of an incoming President who has not previously served on the Board, the outgoing President shall remain as an ex-officio member of the Board for a term of one year, mentoring and assisting the incoming President.
4. All Board members shall be confessing and practicing Christians who subscribe to the Purpose Statements and Principles of the Elk Island Logos Society. No more than 49% of the Board members are to come from the same church body.
5. Members of the clergy and religious orders are prohibited from becoming members of the Board.
6. Whenever a vacancy occurs before the end of the term of a Board member, the Board may appoint a Member to fill that vacancy for the balance of the term.
7. The Board shall, subject to the By-Laws or direction given it by a majority at any meeting properly called and constituted, have full control and management of the affairs of the Society.
8. Since the Logos Christian Program is under the direct control and authority of Elk Island Public Schools (eips), the Board will represent both the Society and the Logos Christian Program in discussions with the Trustees and Administration of eips regarding (a) the long-term planning and development of the Program; (b) monitoring and evaluation of the effectiveness of the Program in cooperation with Elk Island Public Schools; and (c) general policies affecting the Program in the individual schools and throughout the Elk Island School District.
9. Any Board member, upon a two-thirds vote of all members of the Board, may be removed from office for any cause which the Board deems reasonable.
